**Robert Leighton (1611-1684)**: That is the main matter of [the Christian's] fear [of God], because their happiness is in His love, and the light of HIs countenance, that is their life. They regard not how the world looks upon them; they care not who frown, so He smile on them; because no other enemy nor evil in the world can deprive them of this but their own sin, therefore that is what they fear most.

It is true; but it is no less true, that if he does not fear to sin, there is no truth in his assurance; it is not the assurance of faith, but the mispersuasion of a secure and profane mind.
