## **Mission of the Month**

### T.R.A.I.N (Truth Reaching Africa In Need)

Pray for Patricko Odhiambo recently commissioned to establish a church in Kapenguria that will serve those in that town as well as those traveling from the village areas of Pokot County for medical and administrative issues. His wife, Monica, is struggling with various health issues. He is currently looking for a suitable dwelling that can house his family and facilitate these ministry goals.

The schools at Kwirir, Apur and Kapterema (that we support) as well as the other 14 schools in the Pokot area have been in session since the beginning of the year with approximately 1,500 children in attendance. Pray that God will use the believing teachers we support to minister God's word to the students as well as the pastors who preach a gospel message at the school assemblies, serve as chaplain and oversee the distribution of funds.

Pray for the 15 gatherings for worship in the Pokot area centered around three main villages: Kasei, Kamketo and Chepkinagh each of which has 2 resident pastors one who speaks the local language and another who focuses on being a chaplain in the schools. Among these men are Andrew Chemolok, Joshua Sitet, Thomas Lokerisa and Peter Nalunyit.

Pray for the 10 men currently being trained in the PTC (Pastoral Training Course), some of whom will serve in Pokot and other gospel-needy areas. They travel bi-monthly to Nairobi for intensive training lectures and then return "home" and complete homework while continuing with ministry or other occupations in their home areas. They are due to attend between March 10-17. Pastor Mark Hatfield, an elder at Grace Baptist Church, Taylors, SC will be traveling along with Jonathan Oue to provide the lectures. Please pray for traveling mercies for both teacher and students.
